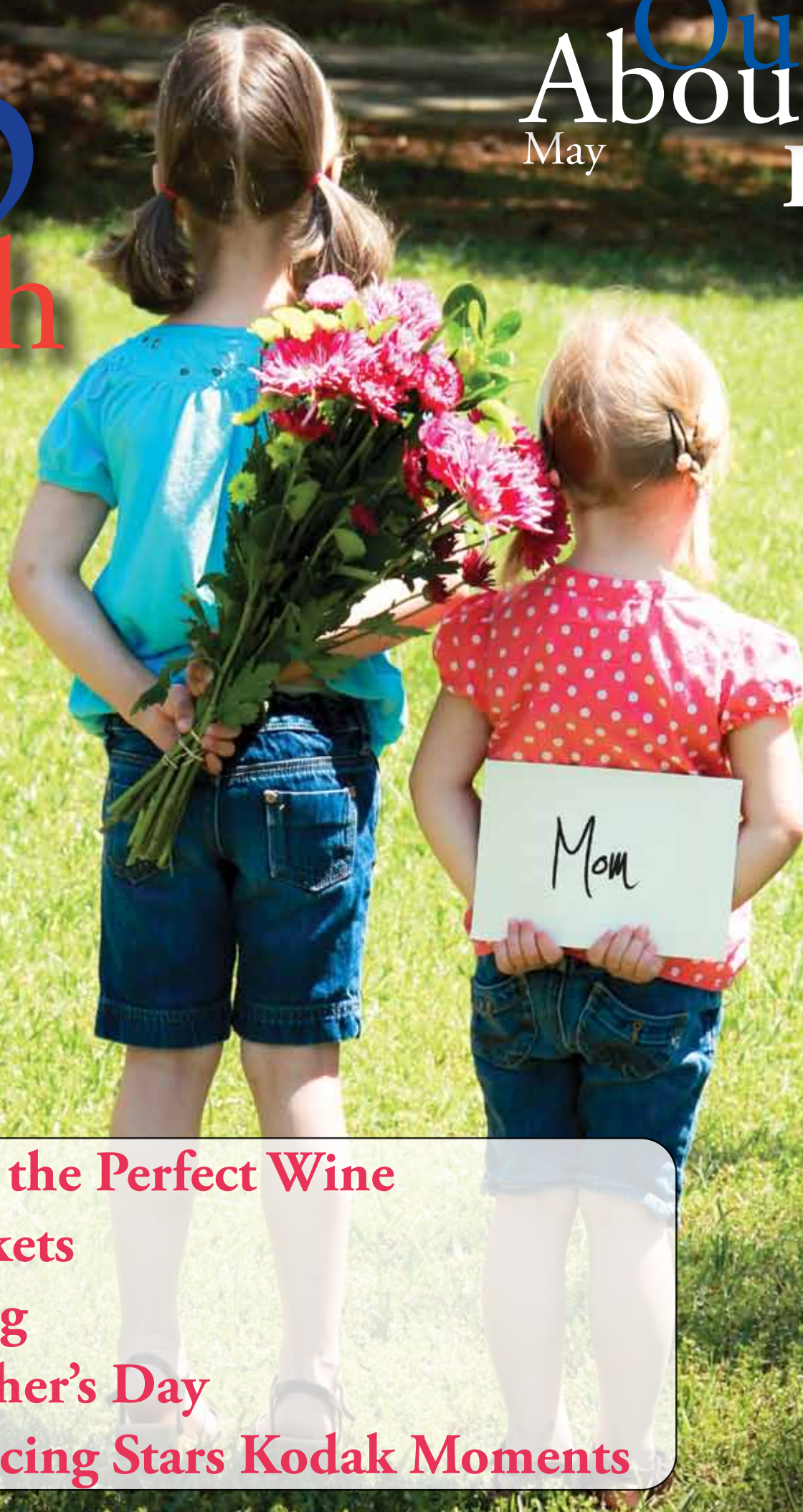

Go Hog Wild at Fox Bros Bar-B-Q

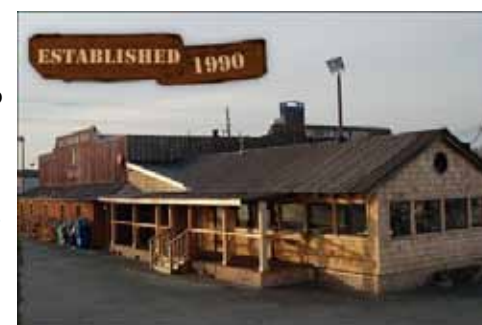
