Our Mission

The longstanding mission of Tanner Medical Foundation is to partner with Tanner Health System in providing ***a continuum of quality healthcare services for all of our citizens*** through the building and strengthening of new and existing philanthropic relationships.

Our Priority

Tanner Health System treats hundreds of patients recovering from stroke, brain injury and other life-changing injuries and illness each year, yet when it's time to leave hospital care, some patients are not yet able to function on their own.

West Georgia is the most populated region in the state without convenient access to a comprehensive inpatient rehabilitation facility like the one being developed at Tanner Medical Center/Carrollton.

Our region's population of people 65 and older is forecast to grow almost 20 percent by 2015, and for an aging population, geographically accessible services are critically important to ensure that these residents receive the appropriate level of care and support.

With a team approach to individualized care, the Tanner Comprehensive Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit (CIPR) will help patients recovering from a variety of conditions and injuries including:

- Stroke
- Brain injury
- Spinal rehab
- Cardiac complications
- Neurological Disorders
- Multiple sclerosis

The facility will offer occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech therapy and will also serve patients who have undergone orthopedic procedures, such as joint replacements, or have experienced physical trauma.

Patients will regain function and independence, and return to their homes, jobs, communities and loved ones. When patients are ready to leave the CIPR, Tanner will offer follow-up services to make sure they safely stay on their road to recovery and good health.

Our Plan

The 20-bed CIPR unit will be constructed at Tanner Medical Center/Carrollton in more than 14,000 square feet, and will feature a new, 320-square-foot transitional living apartment, a 1,000-square-foot "gym"/activity space and a more than 900-square-foot dining/day room.

The transitional living apartment will be in the model of an efficiency apartment, with a kitchen, standard-style living space and more to enable occupational therapists to help patients transition back to a regular, non-hospital environment. The 19 other rooms will be private.
